U.S. Cavalry Frontier History Camp

Step back in time and spend a week as a U.S. Cavalry soldier on the Texas frontier. Live the life of a soldier with authentic 1870's cavalry uniforms, carbines, cannons, equipment, and tents. You'll learn cannon and carbine drills, reenactment shooting safety procedures, skirmish drills, make cartridges, fire Civil War era cannons and Cavalry carbines, and participate in reenactment battles. Cavalry uniforms provided for Cavalry participants.

Frontier History participants must be at least 13 years old. Bring lots of warm clothing. Cavalry Troopers need thermal underwear and insulating garments to wear under cavalry uniforms, plus sleeping bags/blankets, pillows, canteen, and camping gear, etc. Cavalry camp ends Dec. 30.

Cost \$195 per person for Cavalry and Texas Ranger Frontier Outpost.
